
How to reach Mario Negri Institute


From Malpensa Airport with public transport





The MALPENSA EXPRESS airport service connects the center of Milano to Malpensa Airport and vice versa (both terminals 1 and 2), with trains 7 days a week. You can take any train to Milano Cadorna or Milano Stazione Centrale and get off at Bovisa Politecnico stop. It will take from 30-35 minutes. https://goo.gl/maps/gGPGmcM78VRUe9n47

From the Train Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico



Walking 5 minutes. Upon exiting the station, go down the staircase at the right, take the road on the left (Via Mariani) then the first on the right (Via La Masa). Continue for approximately 100 meters, take the street on the left (Via Mario Negri) that leads to the entrance of the Institute.

From Linate Airport with public transport



Take M4 (urban public transport ticket, the same until Mario Negri). Drop off in Dateo and go the Passante ferroviario station. From one of the following trains to Bovisa.

- S13, Direction Bovisa
- S1 Direction Saronno
- S2, Direction Meda/Mariano

(then, see: from the Train Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico)

From Orio al Serio Airport with public transport



Outside the Orio al Serio airport there are several "shuttle" buses that will take you to the Milano Central Station (about 50 minutes of travel)

From Cadorna train station

If you are in the metro, rise to the surface and enter the train station. Take a Railways train North (Ferrovie Nord) (all destinations), get off at Bovisa Politecnico stop. (2 stops with all trains; one stop if you take the Malpensa Express, at platform 1) (then, see: from the Train Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico)

From Central Station

It is possible to take the train to Malpensa (Platform 1) and get off at the Milano stop Bovisa Politecnico (2 stops).

(then, see: from the Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico)

Alternatively, take metro, green line (line 2) until Milano Cadorna (easier), or Milano Porta Garibaldi.

From Porta Garibaldi Station

This station has two levels: surface and underground. Take the underground level (look for the indication: S1, S2, etc. Linee Sotterranee). From the underground (Passante) take one of these trains (platform 2):

- S13, Direction Bovisa
- S1 Direction Saronno
- S2, Direction Meda/Mariano


With these trains get off at Milano Bovisa Politecnico (2 stops). (then, see: from the Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico)

- S5, Direction Varese
- S6, Direction Novara

With these trains get off at Milano Villapizzone (2 stops).

From the Train Station Milano Villapizzone


The walking distance is 10 min (longer than from Milano Bovisa). At the exit from the station take Via Lambruschini, on the left Via Fusinato, on the right Via Giampietrino, Via Codigoro to Via La Masa then take a right to Mario Negri.





Stations along the "Passante"

There are several stations in Milano which may be near your hotel; e.g. Porta Garibaldi, Repubblica, Porta Venezia are areas where you can find a good hotel staying downtown. See the map below.



From Milano Domodossola Station

Take any train **not** to Milano Cadorna. 1 stop.

From Downtown Milano

From the underground (Passante) take one of these trains:

- S3 or S3, Direction Bovisa
- S1, Direction Saronno)
- S2, Direction Meda/Mariano

With these trains get off at Milano Bovisa Politecnico (2 stops). (then, see: from the Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico)

- S5, Direction Varese
- S6, Direction Novara

With these trains get off at Milano Villapizzone (2 stops). (then, see: from the Station Milano Villapizzone)

.Underground

Line 2 (green) get off at Cadorna (easier way) or Porta Garibaldi Station.

Line 1 (red) get off at Cadorna.

Line 5 (purple) get off at Garibaldi.



The bus 82 and 92 have stops near the Station Milano Bovisa Politecnico.

Public transport ticket

In Milano you can use the same ticket (cost 2.20 €) and take the metro, bus and trains (including Passante within the city limits) for 90 minutes. You can use multiple types of transport during the validity time. Please keep your ticket during the whole trip as it will be requested to exit.

You can use also your credit card to pay the fare directly on buses/metro stations **but not on the S lines or Trenord trains** so it's not convenient if you need to take metro/buses + train to Bovisa because you will pay the fare twice. Please remember to swipe your credit card when you exit as well. FAQ on contactless payments:

Bus Ticket from Orio al Serio to Milano Centrale is about 10 €
